RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY - 4

Orchard Hill, **WINDLESHAM** – entry gained via rear door and an untidy search has taken place and jewellery and cash stolen. Occurred on 10/06/24 between 22:50hrs and 23:45hrs.

Ashwell Avenue, **CAMBERLEY** – attempted burglary of a house where a window was broken. Occurred between 19/06/24 23:40hrs and 20/06/24 00:01hrs.

Coleford Bridge Road, MYTCHETT – attempted burglary of a house where a glass door has been smashed. Occurred on 21/06/24 at 22:30hrs.

Hall Close, **CAMBERLEY** – entry gained via first floor window, not known if anything was taken. Occurred on 22/06/26 at 00:30hrs.
