BURGLARY BUSINESS AND COMMUNITY - 0

RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY - 4

Withy Close, **LIGHTWATER** – entry gained via rear doors, and personal items stolen. Occurred between 00:00hrs on 20/03/24 and 14:07hrs on 25/03/24.

Minden Court, **DEEPCUT** – entry gained via ground floor window and untidy search of upstairs conducted and personal items and cash stolen. Occurred at 20:45hrs on 28/03/204.

Bagshot Road, **CHOBHAM** – entry gained via bedroom window on the first floor, untidy search has taken place and a large amount of antique and sentimental jewellery have been stolen. Occurred at 19:45hrs on 29/03/24.
